ORDINANCE NO. 1

1972

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE, FOR GRID OR OTHER PURPOSES, THE AREA EASTERLY OF AND WITHIN 30 FEET OF PORT DOCK #5 WALKWAY OF THE PORT OF NEWPORT, LINCOLN COUNTY, OREGON, PRESCRIBING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PORT OF NEWPORT, LINCOLN COUNTY, OREGON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to moor or place or permit to be moored, placed, any watercraft, boat or vessell, within 30 feet of the easterly edge of Port of Newport, Dock #5 Walkway, for the purpose of mooring or placing or any other use which would make such watercraft, boat or vessell stationary within said described area.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished as provided by law.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that as such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Port of Newport and its citizens, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon adoption.

This ordinance is declared adopted this 13th day of March, 1972.
