PORT OF NEWPORT ORDINANCE NO. 1-85

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 1, 1974:

WHEREAS, the Port of Newport, on April 8, 1974, adopted Ordinance No. 1, 1974 providing for regulation of port facilities; and,

WHEREAS, said ordinance and amendments thereto provide for moorage assignment and use permits, among other things to regulate the use of said moorage facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the decrease in usage of said facilities no longer requires that vessels be assigned temporary moorage on a sub-let basis whereby a permittee may notify the Port that his space is available for sub-letting;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PORT OF NEWPORT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

 $\underline{\text{Section 8.}}$ Subsection 8.9 of said Ordinance No. 1, 1974, as codified, is amended to read as follows:

8.9 <u>Sub-letting</u>: The moorage space designated by the use permit may not be sub-let by the permittee. Nothing within the limitations herein shall restrict the emergency and/or temporary utilization of any vacant space within the Port facilities by the Port. However, such utilization shall be managed to provide for minimum impact upon permanently assigned spaces.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after thirty days from the date of its passage. and first publication.
