SOUTH BEACH RV PARK AND MARINA RULES & REGULATIONS:

All Facilities

- Check-in time is 2 pm; Check-out time is 12 noon
- **Check-out time is strictly enforced.** Over-stays will be charged for a full night's stay
- All fees are **payable in advance**. Failure to pay for RV sites, moorage, launching or parking will result in a citation. (FC 5.29 and 6.24)
- Quiet hours are 10 pm to 8 am - Generators to be turned to be off during this time; no medical exceptions. (FC 6.29)
- Speed limit in the RV Park and South Beach Marina is 5 mph.
- Background checks will be required of first-time guests staying 30 days or more.

Pets

- Pets must be kept on a leash **at all times**. Pets must not be left unattended and are not permitted tied outside without the owner present. Do not tie your animal to electrical or water hook-ups. (FC 6.28)
- Pets are not allowed in the restrooms or shower facilities.
- Clean up after your pet. (Violation 2.43(d)).
- Unattended pets may result in intervention by animal control. (Violation 2.43(d))

Children

- All children under the age of 13 must be under adult supervision **at all times**.
- Children the age of 12 and under are not permitted on the docks without a life preserver. Loaner life jackets are available in a kiosk by the launch ramp. (FC 2.45)

Marina Basics

- Speed limit in the Marina is 5 mph.
- Cleaning of fish and crab must be done at the provided fillet tables found near the docks. (FC 2.43)
- Crabbing & Fishing are permitted on the public service pier only during daylight hours for the general public. Moorage holders may also fish or crab from their boat or assigned slip. (FC 2.44)
- Be respectful of other patrons of the Marina.
- Do not leave trash on the docks. (FC 2.21)
- Do not block pathways on the docks. (FC 5.24(c))
- All fish waste should be disposed of in designated fish dumpsters. (FC 2.21)
- Cooking crab is permitted in bunkers, fillet table areas, and campsites only, NOT on docks. **Please do not dump boil water in grass areas.**

RV Park Basics

- No tents; RVs only.
- No trailer is permitted on premises without a working tow vehicle.
- Keep your area neat and clean. (FC 6.27)
- Clothes lines are not permitted.
- No open campfires or open flames are permitted within 15 feet of a structure, vehicle, trailer or combustible material. Propane crab cookers are also prohibited within five feet of a structure or vehicle. Portable propane grills and warmers are allowed in campsites and picnic bunkers. (FC 6.26)
- Do not walk through other patrons sites.
- Be respectful of your neighbors.
- Unruly behavior is unacceptable and may result in a notice to vacate.
- Onsite repairs of a vehicle are not permitted.
- Restrooms are not to be used to wash clothing or dishes.
- Washing of RVs or cars on site is not permitted.
- Vehicles should not be parked on the grass or sticking out into the roadway. Extra vehicles should be registered with the park office and will not be allowed to park in empty RV sites.
