## PORT OF NEWPORT

## ORDINANCE NO. 2 - /978

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1, 1974, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1, 1975.

WHEREAS, the Port of Newport, on April 8, 1974, adopted Ordinance No. 1, 1974 providing for regulation of port facilities; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance and amendments thereto provide for moorage assignment and use permits, among other things, to regulate the use of said moorage facilities; and

WHEREAS, the extreme increase in usage of said facilities requires that vessels be moored only in assigned or designated moorages and that the same be at all times properly moored;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PORT OF NEWPORT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Subsection 8.10 of said Ordinance No. 1, 1974, as codified, is amended to read as follows:

Temporary Use of Moorage Facilities. 8.10. Prior to using port facilities for temporary moorage by any vessel, boat, ship or craft, the owner or operator or any person having charge or responsibility therefor shall first contact the port by and through its agents and register said vessel, boat, ship or craft and receive from the port an assigned moorage space or otherwise ascertain a place or location for moorage in accordance with the rules, regulations and posted instructions of the port then obtaining for such vessel, boat, ship or craft, and payment for said moorage shall be made in advance prior to said mooring; provided, however, that such vessel, boat, ship or other craft may, with due regard to all ordinances, rules, regulations, posted instructions or verbal instructions of any authorized port representatives, be moored to the designated area for temporary moorage for a period not to exceed two (2) hours without having first contacted said port, it being expressly provided that the owner, operator and/or any person having responsibility or charge thereof will be responsible for all moorage charges from the time of said moorage.

Section 2. Section 2 of said Ordinance No. 1, 1975, amending and adding to Ordinance No. 1, 1974, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Moorage Assignment Required. No person shall moor or dock a vessel at port facilities for more than two (2) hours without first prepaying moorage fees and obtaining a location assignment from the Port of Newport.

Section 3. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and

welfare, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
