Port Dock 5 Power to be Temporarily Disconnected

At 8:00 a.m. Monday, January 30, through Friday, February 3, electrical power will be disconnected from Port Dock 5 at the commercial marina. The gangway access to Port Dock 5 will also be closed. Dock 5 will be accessible only from Port Dock 3 by a temporary connecting dock. Disruption of the commercial marine fueling facility is not anticipated during this time.

Upgrades at Port Dock 5 include replacing the existing timber support header, which connects the access pier to the existing gangway, with a new steel support header, and replacing the gangway and landing float. Work also includes replacing six, 14-inch diameter creosote wooden piling with two, 20-inch diameter steel pipe piling to provide support for the new header.
